Blessed Sacrament/Joan of Arc– 6 members attended the last rosary. 10 members attended their monthly meeting and mass.


- **Christ The King** 14 members attended their monthly mass. 22 members attended their monthly meeting and 14 members attended their Radio Rosary recitation.

Staying Through Scandal
